The software provides a friendly user environment for the main actions of routine site inspections:

- Findings grouping and evaluation
- Pictures and supporting documentation attachment
- Real time statistics
- Actionees allocation for each finding



#### Inspections - Findings


Each inspection includes a set of finding records and a set of automatically calculated real time statistics.

For each finding, the following pieces of information can be specified:

- Reference Number (automatically generated unique)
- Subject (selection from predefined list)
- Finding (formatted text)
- References (selection from predefined list)
- Actionee (selection from predefined list)
- Priority (selection from predefined list)
- Status (selection from predefined list)
- Attached photo



#### Real time statistics

#### Statistics are constantly computed based on:

- Current inspection records
- Current month records
- Project records

#### **Statistics include:**

- Count of findings per category (Raised / Pending / Closed / Critical)
- Percentage of findings per category based on:
  - Current Inspection
  - Previous Month
  - Last three months



#### Reporting


For each inspection, SIR produces reports which include the following sections:

- Section A: contains all records from the beginning of the project up to the previous month
- Section B: contains all records of the working inspection
- Section C: contains all the records which belong to the current inspection month (excluding the working inspection)
- Statistics (for each section)
- Photos (for each section)
- Top subjects (relative percentage)



#### Report options

- Sections to include (A / B / C)
- Whether to include photos for each section
- Output format (Excel / PDF)
- Inclusion of References / Actionees
- Top subjects








#### Multiple language support
